3 **Resolution declaring May 16 through 20, 2005, as Public Works Week.**

5 WHEREAS, Public Works programs and services provided in the City and County of
6 San Francisco are delivered by a professional and committed staff of public works employees;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, It is the mission of the San Francisco Department of Public Works to
9 improve the quality of life in San Francisco through teamwork, customer service and
10 continuous improvement in partnership with the community; and

11 WHEREAS, Public Works programs and services, provided twenty-four hours a day in
12 San Francisco, are an integral part of our citizens' everyday lives; and

13 WHEREAS, An important feature of National Public Works Week is the recognition that
14 public private partnerships between the city and its residents, businesses and visitors, is vital
15 to the success of public works projects and to the improvement of our quality of life; and

16 WHEREAS, National Public Works Week is an annual weeklong event that celebrates
17 the women and men of the department who make daily contributions in public works-related
18 efforts, including graffiti removal, tree planting and maintenance; neighborhood beautification
19 and clean-ups; street and sewer repair; architecture and engineering services; and street use
20 and mapping services; collectively known as public works; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims May 16 through 20, 2005,
22 as Public Works Week in San Francisco and commends the men and women of the
23 Department of Public Works while calling upon all residents, businesses, and organizations to
24 work in partnership with the department as it improves the quality of life in San Francisco.


