Resolution authorizing the Department of the Environment to apply for grant funds in the amount of \$726,400 from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District for the purpose of implementing programs to improve air quality.

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 434 created the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the Bay Area and provided authority to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (the District) to impose up to a \$4.00 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees within its jurisdiction, to be used to implement specified transportation control measures included in the District's 1991 Bay Area Clean Air Plan; and,

WHEREAS, The District has approved a surcharge on motor vehicles and is seeking applications from Bay Area cities, counties, school districts and other agencies to cover the cost of transportation programs and projects that achieve emission reductions from motor vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports the Bay Area Clean Air Plan; and,

WHEREAS, The following programs and projects are eligible for AB 434 program funding; emissions reduction retrofit equipment for Golden Gate Disposal and Recycling Company and Sunset Scavenger Company (\$462,000), and a partnership with the San Francisco Bicycle Coalition and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission, to promote the use of bicycles as a clean air mobility alternative to using motor vehicles (\$256,000); and,

WHEREAS, The District requires all applications to be authorized by the applicant's governing board, or in this case, the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, An accept and expend resolution and any additional necessary documentation will be provided, as required, in the event that these projects are designated for District funding awards; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Director of the Department of the Environment is authorized to apply for funding from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District's Transportation Fund for Clean Air.
