**Resolution urging the San Francisco Department of Parking and Traffic to deliver an interim report by October 5, 2005 concerning traffic flow and pedestrian safety on Octavia Boulevard and its adjoining freeway off-ramp.**

WHEREAS, On September 9, 2005 Octavia Boulevard and its adjoining off-ramp opened for public use; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Parking and Traffic is expected to make a status report within six months subsequent to the above date concerning any recommended changes regarding traffic flow and pedestrian safety at the off-ramp and on the street itself; and,

WHEREAS, there have been numerous traffic accidents reported since Octavia Boulevard opened, that there is considerable pedestrian traffic in this area, and understanding that six months is a substantial period of time; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests that the DPT makes an interim report by October 5, 2005 as to the condition of traffic congestion and traffic safety in this Octavia Boulevard corridor, and to give any recommendations that they see fit.
