5 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code
6 and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of
7 vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

RIGHT LANE MUST TURN RIGHT - RESCIND

9

Stanyan Street, west side, from Fulton Street to 120 feet northerly

10

NO LEFT TURN, 4 PM TO 6 PM - RESCIND

11

NO LEFT TURN, 11 AM TO 6 PM, EVERYDAY, EXCEPT TAXIS - ESTABLISH

12

Fulton Street, eastbound and westbound, at Stanyan Street

13

NO LEFT TURN - ESTABLISH

14

Fulton Street, eastbound, at 10th Avenue

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.




