7 have on local communities; and,

8 WHEREAS, San Francisco has placed a high priority on the disaster preparedness of
9 its citizens; and,

10 WHEREAS, The Office of Emergency Services and Homeland Security has made
11 significant strides in public education through its many outreach activities, including the
12 creation of a new website – 72hours.org – which provides a step-by-step outline of how to get
13 prepared; and,

14 WHEREAS, Some of these steps include preparing an emergency supply kit, making a
15 family emergency plan, becoming informed about different threats, and becoming involved in
16 community disaster preparations; and,

17 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Office of Emergency Services and Homeland Security
18 is sponsoring its annual Citywide Earthquake Awareness and Education Fair at the Marina
19 Green during Fleet Week festivities on October 8-9; and,

20 WHEREAS, By becoming prepared in the event of a disaster, San Franciscans can
21 help protect themselves, their families and their communities; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
23 proclaim October San Francisco Disaster Preparedness Month.




