9 become aware of the difficulties and dangers that children face on their trip to school; and,

10 WHEREAS, Community leaders and parents should determine the "walkability" of their
11 community; and,

12 WHEREAS, Everyone should make a plan to make immediate changes to increase the
13 safety of children who are walking in our communities and a lot of suggestions for
14 improvements that can be done over time; and,

15 WHEREAS, Children, parents and community leaders are joining together nationwide
16 to walk to school and evaluate pedestrian safety in their community; and,

17 WHEREAS, October 3-7, 2005 is recognized as International Walk to School Week;

19 WHEREAS, This year, more than 3 million walkers from around the world will walk to
20 school together for various reasons – all hoping to create communities that are safe places to
21 walk, now, therefore, be it

22 **RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors declares October 5, 2005**
