11 WHEREAS, Sidewalk Pocket Park Gardens transform a small sidewalk cutout for trees
12 into enlarged space for roots resulting in infrastructure savings on sidewalk replacement; and,

13 WHEREAS, Sidewalk gardens provide better conditions for trees, allowing for longer
14 lives, more vibrant canopies and optimal size and stature; and,

15 WHEREAS, The presence of beautiful public space encourages people to walk, spend
16 time outdoors, and interact; and,

17 WHEREAS, Plant*SF and Sidewalk Pocket Park Gardens incorporate community
18 development, environmental design and public health into projects with numerous benefits;
19 now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends the ongoing work of Plant*SF,
21 Sidewalk Pocket Park Gardens and other projects that promote community-based permeable
22 landscaping and public open-space gardens located on public rights-of-way throughout San
23 Francisco.


