12 models and to be instilled with the richness of their ethnicity and values of their legacy; and,

13 WHEREAS, American Indians have participated with distinction in United States
14 military actions for more than 200 years; their courage, determination and fighting spirit having
15 been recognized by American military leaders as early as the 18th century; and,

16 WHEREAS, In 1990 President George Bush approved a joint resolution designating
17 November 1990 "National American Indian Heritage Month"; now, therefore, be it

18 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors declares November 2005 as "American
19 Indian Heritage Month" in the City and County of San Francisco.
