Resolution endorsing the San Francisco Fire Department and Historical Society 1906 Great Earthquake and Fire Expo and declaring said Expo an official event of the City's Centennial observances.

WHEREAS, The year 2006 marks the 100th anniversary of the San Francisco Great Earthquake and Fire of 1906; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Great Earthquake and Fire of 1906 destroyed the City and was known as one of the worst disasters to ever befall an American city; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Fire Chief Dennis Sullivan was killed during the disaster and the San Francisco Fire Department struggled against all odds to save the barely 50-year-old City; and

WHEREAS, The special place that San Francisco retained in the hearts and minds of everyone who knew of it inspired generous financial assistance from Asia, Europe, Latin America, corporations and private citizens; and

WHEREAS, With the Phoenix as its guide, San Francisco rose from the ashes to grow and prosper, rebuilding, creating one of three American civic centers, sponsoring the 1915 Panama-Pacific Exposition, becoming the great, 20th century city, known as the Queen of the West; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco became a pioneering city in the area of labor rights, civil rights, tolerance and freedom of expression; and

WHEREAS, San Francisco, with its reputation for open discourse, diversity of its citizenry and natural beauty remains one of the premiere destination cities in the world; and


