RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

BICYCLE LANE - ESTABLISH

Scott Street, northbound, from Haight Street to Oak Street.

LEFT TURN BICYCLE LANE - ESTABLISH

Scott Street, northbound, from Oak Street to Fell Street..

NO TURN ON RED - ESTABLISH

Scott Street, northbound, at Oak Street.

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.




