14 300+ volunteer mediators, who reflect the ethnic, gender, marital, age and religious diversity
15 of San Francisco; and,

16 WHEREAS, Community Boards works with city agencies to maximize their services to
17 the general public and to minimize disruptions from their core missions; and,

18 WHEREAS, Community Boards' violence prevention model for youth, the Conflict
19 Manager Program, now in its twenty-fifth year, is used in over 3500 schools in the United
20 States and internationally; now, therefore, be it


