3 **Resolution supporting the rights of employees of Field Research Corporation in their**  
4 **attempt to form a union and urging Field Research Corporation to desist from its**  
5 **unethical and borderline illegal anti-union behavior.**

8 WHEREAS, one of the most essential civil rights is the right to form a union at one's  
9 workplace; and

10 WHEREAS, Corporate America is systematically helping to disrupts, deny and  
11 dismantle workers rights in this country, making the need for law reform urgent; and

12 WHEREAS, Field Research Corporation is a well-known San Francisco marketing and  
13 public opinion research firm whose corporate headquarters are located at 222 Sutter Street,  
14 and who operates a call center at 703 Market Street; and

15 WHEREAS, Field Research Corporation has revenues in the millions of dollars, only  
16 pays pennies above the minimum wage required by San Francisco law, and doesn't offer  
17 healthcare to the overwhelming majority of their employees; and

18 WHEREAS, Employees of Field Research have joined together to form a union to  
19 improve their wages, benefits and working conditions

20 WHEREAS, Field Research Corporation Management is in the process of interfering  
21 with their workers' efforts to have a collective bargaining rights by conducting anti-union  
22 "captive audience" meetings; and,

23 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors has a long history of working to  
24 safeguard labor standards and employment rights of workers inside and outside of San  
25 Francisco; and,

8 employees and calls on them to immediately stop interfering with their right to form a union.
