3 **Resolution enacting angle parking regulations on the east side of Noe**
4 **Street, between 29th and Day Streets.**

6 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic, at the request of the
7 community and of Supervisor Bevan Dufty's office, has surveyed the area of Noe
8 Street between 29th and Day Streets and has found no impediment to angled parking;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, Angled parking will increase the number of parking spaces
11 available on this block, mitigating the parking impact of a concurrent proposal to enact
12 a school bus loading zone at Mission Education Center on Noe and 30th Streets; now,
13 therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle
15 Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations upon the parking of
16 vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

18 **90-DEGREE ANGLE PARKING – ESTABLISH**

19 Noe Street, east side, between 29th and Day Streets

21 Categorically exempt from Environmental
22 Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and
23 parking regulations where such changes do not
24 establish a higher speed limit or result in more
25 than a negligible increase in the use of the
street.




