5 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code
6 and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the parking of
7 vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

8 **RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING AREA "D", 4-HOUR TIME LIMIT, 9 AM to 5 PM,**
9 **MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY - ESTABLISH**

10 Bosworth Street, north side, from Chilton Avenue to Elk Street.

11 **2-HOUR TIME LIMIT, 9 AM TO 6 PM, MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY - RESCIND**

12 Bosworth Street, north side, from Chilton Avenue to Elk Street.

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review
Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking
regulations where such changes do not establish a
higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible
increase in the use of the street.




