

1 [Grant to fund a project through the HIV Epidemiology Section of the Department of Public
2 Health.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$19,601 from the Global Fund**
5 **to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria through the Regents of the University of**
6 **California to fund the Triangulation Resource Guide, and to enter into an agreement for**
7 **the use of these funds; for the period of September 1, 2006 through June 3, 2007.**

9 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant in the amount of \$19,601 from the Global Fund
10 to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria through the Regents of the University of California to
11 support the Triangulation Resource Guide project; and,

12 WHEREAS, DPH's HIV Epidemiology Section will use these funds to 1) assist in the
13 production of a generic resource manual presenting in detail the triangulation method for
14 analyzing, interpreting and using data; 2) contribute to the production of case studies
15 delineating triangulation exercises; 3) participate in the Malawi Triangulation training
16 workshop; and 4) attend the Malawi Global Fund evaluation planning meeting; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, the Global Fund to Fight AIDS,
18 Tuberculosis and Malaria through the Regents of the University of California requires the City
19 to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
20 Board of Supervisors in File No. 070891; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
21 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

22 WHEREAS, the grant does not require an ASO amendment and partially reimburses
23 the department for two existing positions, including Epidemiologist III (Job Class 2804) at .05

1 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$2,100; now,
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
4 in the amount of \$19,601 from the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria
5 through the Regents of the University of California; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
7 expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement,
8 pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
10 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
12 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
13 the agreement expires.


