4 **Resolution Urging the Department of Public Works to immediately assemble a working**
5 **group to develop a "Citizens How To Underground Kit" providing Citizens with advice**
6 **and information on their options to help underground their neighborhoods.**

7 WHEREAS, Undergrounding Utility Wires achieves a greater safety for the Citizens of
8 the City and County of San Francisco, increases the reliability of the Utilities and increases
9 the overall aesthetics of San Francisco; and

10 WHEREAS; The Citizens of San Francisco overwhelmingly want their utility wires to be
11 placed underground as soon as possible; and

12 WHEREAS, As of now, the City has not provided the Citizens with a tool kit that allows
13 them to assess their options for undergrounding in their respective neighborhoods; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Utility Undergrounding Task Force recommended that a "Citizens
15 How to Kit" be prepared by relevant City Departments to assist citizens in determining
16 how to best move undergrounding forward in their neighborhood; and

17 WHEREAS, The "Citizens How to Kit" should contain the legal requirements, advice on
18 how to organize neighborhoods for a 20B project, estimated resources, agency contact
19 information and any other relevant information determined necessary by the work group; and

20 WHEREAS, The working group should begin work immediately and include staff from
21 the Department of Public Works, the City Attorney's Office, the San Francisco Public
22 Utility Commission, the Mayor's Office, the Mayor's Office of Public Finance, Supervisor
23 Dufty's office and the City Administrator's Office; and be it


