2 AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN  
3 FRANCISCO TO RETROACTIVELY ACCEPT AND EXPEND A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF  
4 \$754,618 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE  
5 ASSISTANCE FOR A PROGRAM ENTITLED "BYRNE 2007 DISCRETIONARY GRANT  
6 PROGRAM; BJA-TARGETING VIOLENT CRIME INTIATIVE".

8 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police for the City and County of San  
9 Francisco desires to undertake a certain project designated "BYRNE  
10 2007 DISCRETIONARY GRANT PROGRAM; BJA-TARGETING VIOLENT CRIME  
11 INTIATIVE", to be funded from funds made available through the U.S.  
12 Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance; and,

13 WHEREAS, The intent of this program will be to conduct  
14 spontaneous and unannounced searches on eligible criminal  
15 probationers to deter further criminal activity; and,

16 WHEREAS, The project will also seek to rescue children from  
17 being exposed to drug dealers in public areas within 1000 feet of  
18 their schools; and,

19 WHEREAS the grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

20 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in  
21 the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police for the City and County of  
23 San Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San  
24 Francisco to retroactively accept and expend continued funding for

1 this project from the U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Bureau of  
2 Justice Assistance (BJA); and be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and  
4 County of San Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the  
5 City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Agreement for  
6 this project including any extensions, funding augmentations from the  
7 USDOJ/BJA, or amendments thereof; and be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising  
9 out of performance of this Grant Agreement, including civil court  
10 actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and  
11 the authorizing agency; and be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not  
13 be used to supplant expenditure controlled by the Board of  
14 Supervisors.
