17 WHEREAS, on March 15, 2007, the Recreation and Park Commission recommended
18 to the Board of Supervisors to accept and expend the Gift as Resolution No. 0703-010; now,

21 Recreation and Park Department to accept and expend the Gift valued at \$25,000 from the
22 United States Tennis Association for the planning needs to renovate Golden Gate Park
23 Tennis Center in Golden Gate Park.


