Resolution determining that the expansion of a bar with a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license currently issued to Brian Sheehy at 501 Jones Street to include the location of 503 Jones Street (District 6), for Bourbon & Branch bar, will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco, in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, with conditions.

WHEREAS, Brian Sheehy is seeking the expansion of a bar with a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license currently at 501 Jones Street to include the location of 503 Jones Street (District 10), for Bourbon & Branch bar; and,

WHEREAS, The Planning Department has verified that the area is properly zoned, subject to conditions set forth in Planning Code Section 249.5(d)(6) (which establishes "Good Neighbor Policies"); and,

WHEREAS, The Police Department recommends that the liquor license application be approved with conditions; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That in accordance with Section 23958.4 of the California Business and Professions Code, the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby determines for the foregoing reasons that the expansion of a bar with a Type 48 on-sale general public premises liquor license currently issued to Brian Sheehy at 501 Jones Street to include the location of 503 Jones Street, for Bourbon & Branch bar, will serve the public convenience and necessity of the people of the City and County of San Francisco.

Conditions: (1) There shall be no coin operated games or video machines maintained upon the premises at any time. (2) No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s). (3) No person under the age of twenty-one (21 years of age) shall sell, furnish, or deliver alcoholic beverages. (4) The sale of alcoholic beverages for consumption off the premises is strictly prohibited. (5) Petitioner shall not permit its patrons or the general public to loiter or congregate on the sidewalks adjacent to the licensed premises. The orderly standing of patrons in line to enter the premises shall not be considered loitering or unlawfully congregating. (6) The petitioner(s) shall be responsible for maintaining free of litter the area adjacent to the premises over which they have control. (7) Petitioner shall not make structural changes in the premises interior without prior written approval from the Police Department. (8) The interior lighting maintained therein shall be sufficient to make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons and patrons in that portion of the premises where alcoholic beverages are sold, served, delivered or consumed. (9) The exterior of the premises shall be equipped with lighting of sufficient power to illuminate and make easily discernible the appearance and conduct of all persons on or about the premises. Additionally, the position of such lighting shall not disturb the normal privacy and use of any neighboring residences. (10) At no time shall any person under the age of 21 enter or remain in these public premises. (11) No reduced price alcoholic beverage promotion shall be allowed.
