13 WHEREAS; Cheryl Johnson was later named the Teamsters' Special Events
14 Coordinator, Director of Community Services, and Secretary to the Disaster Relief Fund, as
15 well as Chairman of the International Teamster's Women's Committee and President of the
16 Teamsters' James R. Hoffa Memorial Scholarship Fund; and

17 WHEREAS; In 2007, Cheryl Johnson became the Central Region Vice for the
18 Teamsters; and

19 WHEREAS; Cheryl Johnson has been a dedicated Teamster Activist for over 38 years;
20 now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors commends Cheryl Johnson
22 on the Bay Area Union Labor Party Labor Leader of the Year Award.
