3 **Resolution declaring the week of March 7th through March 14th as Arbor Week in San**

6 WHEREAS, Trees provide a host of benefits to the City, including improved air quality,
7 increased storm water diversion from our combined sewer system; improved wildlife habitat,
8 improved psychological well-being, and improved aesthetic environment; and,

10 WHEREAS, The goal of Arbor Week 2009 is to celebrate the City's accomplishment of
11 planting 25,000 trees since 2005 and to emphasize the importance of caring for these newly
12 planted trees; and,

13 WHEREAS, Increasing the urban forest supports San Francisco's Livable Streets
14 Initiative; and,

15 WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works, the Mayor's Office of Neighborhood
16 Services, the Recreation and Park Department, SF Environment, Friends of the Urban Forest,
17 SF Parks Trust, the SF Unified School District, American Express, Walgreens, AAA, SF
18 Botanical Garden, SF Public Utilities Commission, SF Housing Authority, SF Laborer's Union,
19 Local 261, Caltrans, Clean City Coalition, Norcal Waste Systems, Inc., SF Public Library, and
20 SF International Airport have worked collaboratively to host Arbor Week activities; and,

21 WHEREAS, Arbor Week will commence on Saturday, March 7th with a neighborhood
22 tree planting in Hayes Valley, continue with a ceremonial tree planting on Wednesday, March
23 11th on South Van Ness Avenue and culminate in a major reforestation effort along Sunset
24 Boulevard on Saturday, March 14th; and,

25 WHEREAS, Arbor Day is celebrated throughout the nation and the world; and,
