

1 [Accept and expend grant – High Risk Program.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to accept**
4 **and expend retroactively a grant from the California Department of Food and**
5 **Agriculture (CDFA) in the amount of \$37,787 to prevent infestation of pests from**
6 **incoming high-risk shipments of plant material from Hawaii, Florida and other southern**
7 **states; for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.**

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9 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from the CDFA in the amount of \$37,787 for a
10 project entitled High Risk Program; for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and,

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of this grant is to prevent infestation of pests from incoming
12 high-risk shipments of plan material from Hawaii, Florida, and other southern states by
13 performing high-risk pest exclusion activities at nurseries or nursery holding facilities; and,

14 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses DPH for
15 four existing positions: two Agricultural Inspectors (job class 3450) at 0.30 FTE, one Manager
16 I (job class 0922) at 0.05 FTE, and one Junior Administrative Analyst (job class 1820) at 0.02
17 FTE, for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010; and,

18 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
19 \$6,193.59; now, therefore, be it


20 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant in the
21 amount of \$37,787 from the CDFA; and, be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions
23 funded under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when
24 the agreement expires; and, be it


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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the


