7 WHEREAS, Brooks Orpik was born in San Francisco in 1980; and,

8 WHEREAS, Brooks Orpik was named for Herb Brooks, who coached the U.S. Hockey  
9 team to a gold medal in the 1980 Winter Olympics, a campaign that included "The Miracle on  
10 Ice" when the United States team, made up of amateur and collegiate players defeated the  
11 Soviet team, considered the best hockey team in the world; and,

12 WHEREAS, On the eve of the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of "The Miracle on Ice", history nearly  
13 repeated itself when Brooks Orpik and the U.S. Hockey team beat Canada; and,

14 WHEREAS, Brooks Orpik is the only San Francisco born member of the 2010 U.S.  
15 Olympic Team; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
17 commends Brooks Orpik for representing our City as the only San Franciscan in the 2010  
18 Winter Olympics.
