

1 [Authorizing the Director of Elections to Make Confidential Certain Voter Registration  
2 Information Pertaining to Public Safety Officers]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Director of Elections to, upon proper application of a public**  
4 **safety officer, make confidential that officer's residence address, telephone number,**  
5 **and e-mail address appearing on the affidavit of registration, in accordance with**  
6 **California Elections Code Section 2166.7.**

8 WHEREAS, California Election Code Section 2166.7 provides that a county board of  
9 supervisors may authorize a county elections official, upon application of a public safety  
10 officer to make confidential that officer's residence address, telephone number, and e-mail  
11 address appearing on the affidavit of registration, in accordance with specified terms and  
12 conditions; and

13 WHEREAS, California Election Code Section 2166 specifically requires demonstration  
14 that 'a life-threatening circumstance exists to the officer or a member of the officer's family'  
15 before granting a request to make personal information confidential;

16 WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors determines it is in the public interest to  
17 implement this confidentiality provision in the City and County of San Francisco; now,  
18 therefore, be it

19 RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Elections,  
20 pursuant to California Elections Code Section 2166.7, to provide for the confidentiality of a  
21 public safety officer's residence address, telephone number, and e-mail address appearing on  
22 the affidavit of registration, upon application of that officer and in accordance with the terms  
23 and conditions set forth at California Elections Code Section 2166.7, which is incorporated by  
24 reference as if fully set forth herein.


