10 WHEREAS, The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in  
11 this Resolution are in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (California  
12 Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the  
13 Board of Supervisors in File No. 100716 and is incorporated herein by reference; and

14 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has authorized the County Agriculture  
15 Commissioner under San Francisco Administrative Code Sections 1.15.1(b) and (c) to  
16 establish a schedule of fees for testing of weighing and measuring devices initiated by written  
17 request and for reinspecting, retesting and recertifying weighing and measuring devices found  
18 to be outside the tolerances or specifications set by the California Department of Food and  
19 Agriculture upon an initial inspection prescribed by California Business and Professions Code  
20 Section 12210(a) and

21 WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 12210.5 of the California Business and Professions  
22 Code and San Francisco Administrative Code Section 1.15.1(b), the fee schedule adopted by  
23 the County Agriculture Commissioner shall be in accordance with those fees established by  
24 the Secretary of Food and Agriculture of the State of California (hereafter referred to as  
25 "Director"); and,

1 WHEREAS, The fees established by the Director in DMS Notice D-08-11 are on file  
2 with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. , and are hereby declared to  
3 be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

4 WHEREAS, The following schedule of fees to be charged by the County Agriculture  
5 Commissioner are found to be in accordance with the fees established by the Director; and,

6 WHEREAS, Pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 1.15.1(d), the fee  
7 schedule adopted by the County Agriculture Commissioner and any changes to the fee  
8 schedule must be ratified by resolution of the Board of Supervisors; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the County Agriculture Commissioner may charge the following  
10 schedule of fees for testing of weighing and measuring devices initiated by written request  
11 and for reinspections, retesting and recertification of weighing and measuring devices that are  
12 found to be outside the tolerances or specifications set by the California Department of Food  
13 and Agriculture upon an initial inspection prescribed by California Business and Professions  
14 Code Section 12210(a):

15 All charges to be on a portal-to-portal basis plus mileage charge as indicated:

- 16 • Small Capacity Scales: \$100.00/hour + \$1.75/mile (up to 10,000 GVW)
- 17 • Large Capacity Scales: \$100.00/hour + \$2.50/mile (10,000 to 40,000 GVW)  
18 (All scales over 3,000 lbs. capacity) \$130.00/hour + \$3.00/mile (more than 40,000 GVW)
- 19 • Retail Gasoline Dispensers: \$70.00/hour + \$1.00/mile
- 20 • Wholesale Petroleum Meters: \$90.00/hour + \$1.50/mile
- 21 • Liquefied Petroleum Gas Meters: \$90.00/hour + \$1.00/mile
- 22 • All Other Commercial Devices: \$70.00/hour + \$1.00/mile
