

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - San Francisco Re-entry Center Program - \$750,000]

2 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County**
3 **of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$750,000**
4 **through the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, for a**
5 **program entitled "San Francisco Re-entry Center" for the grant period of October 1,**
6 **2010, through March 31, 2012.**

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8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to create a certain project
9 designated the San Francisco Re-entry Center to be funded in part from funds made available
10 through the United States Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Assistance (hereafter
11 "BJA"); and

12 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment; and

13 WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize use of available grant funds on
14 program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of
16 the City and County of San Francisco to accept and expend funds from BJA for the purposes
17 of establishing a Re-entry Center; and be it


18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
19 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of
21 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for re-entry
22 program implementation and operation purposes, including any extensions, augmentations or
23 amendments thereof; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized and empowered to
2 execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all
3 applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the
4 purpose of securing re-entry center grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes
5 specified in the applicable grant application; and be it


6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant
7 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the
8 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and that the grant recipient and the authorizing
9 agency will hold BJA harmless from any claims that may arise from the use of grant funds.

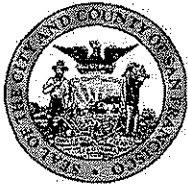
