8 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department applied for and was awarded
9 \$200,000 in funding from the California Emergency Management Agency for the Anti-Human
10 Trafficking Task Force (HF) Program; and

11 WHEREAS, The purpose of the grant is to support enforcement activities to expand our
12 existing multi-disciplinary task forces to improve both the law enforcement response to all
13 elements of human trafficking and the coordination between disciplines to ensure that a
14 comprehensive continuum of care is provided to the victims of human trafficking; and

15 WHEREAS, The award period is from October 1, 2012 through September 30, 2013;
16 and

17 WHEREAS, The grant does not include any provision for indirect costs; and

18 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department is seeking retroactive approval
19 because it did not receive the grant award until December 6, 2012; and

20 WHEREAS, This grant does not create any new positions, and will not require an
21 amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance; now, therefore, be it


22 **RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Police Department is authorized to retroactively**
