5 **\$848,059 from the California Natural Resources Agency for the Mansell Corridor Project**
6 **in McLaren Park for the period of February 1, 2015, through May 1, 2017.**

8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco (“the City”) owns Assessor’s Parcel
9 Block 6003, Lot 034, Block 6096 Lot 001, Block 6189, Lot 034, Block 6190, Lot 066 and Block
10 6220, Lot 002 known as “McLaren Park”; and

11 WHEREAS, The City, through the San Francisco Recreation and Park Department
12 (“RPD”) is responsible for operating and maintaining these properties; and

13 WHEREAS, The California Natural Resources Agency’s Strategic Growth Council is
14 responsible for administration of the Urban Greening for Sustainable Communities Grant
15 Program funded by the Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality and Supply, Flood Control, River
16 and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006 (Proposition 84); and

17 WHEREAS, The Strategic Growth Council has awarded the City a grant in the amount
18 of \$848,059 (“Grant”) for Mansell Corridor Improvement Project; and

19 WHEREAS, The terms and conditions of the Grant is detailed in the Agreement on file
20 at the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 150311 which is hereby declared to be
21 part of this resolution as set forth fully herein; and


22 WHEREAS, The Grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; and


23 WHEREAS, The Grant will not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance;


1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs
