Member Safai moved that this Ordinance be DUPLICATED AND AMENDED, AN AMENDMENT OF THE WHOLE BEARING NEW TITLE, on Page 1, Lines, 5-6, to strike 'and to require consideration of available contractor performance evaluations when considering contractors for award of a public works construction contract'; on Page 1, lines 20-25, to strike 'The performance evaluation shall include, but is not limited to, documentation as applicable of any notice of violation, citation, third party claim filed against the City in connection with the Contractor's work, or instance of non-compliance with Contract terms and conditions. (b) A department shall consider relevant Contractor performance evaluations, if available, when the department evaluates a Contractor's Responsibility for award of a Contract'; on Page 3, Lines 14-15, and on Page 5, Lines 2-3, to strike 'The cost criterion shall constitute not less than 40% of the overall evaluation'; on Page 5, Line 10, to replace 'March 1, 2023' with 'July 1, 2023' and make other complying and conforming changes.
