The following information is provided by a speaker, pursuant to Administrative Code Section 67.16. The content is neither generated by, nor subject to approval or verification of accuracy by, the Clerk of the Board or the Board of Supervisors.

Paul Currier submitted the following additional information during the hearing relating to File No. 120949 as follows: All through these hearings of the Mayor's charges against the Sheriff, the Ethics Commission violated the Brown Act and the San Francisco Sunshine Ordinance. None of the proceedings were properly agendized. None of the minutes were issues in a timely manner, according to law. Public records were not made available to the public. And the charges shape/shifted without any specificity open to review or public comment. In fact, this October 9, 2012, hearing of the Board of Supervisors is improperly agendized. The Ethics Commission and the Board of Sup[ervisors have committed official misconduct.
