Vice Chair Mandelman, seconded by Member Ronen, moved that this Resolution be AMENDED, AN AMENDMENT OF THE WHOLE BEARING NEW TITLE, by increasing the increased grant amount from '\$3,100,150' to '\$13,100,570' for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$33,590,570, and replacing the end of the grant period from 'June 30, 2023' to December 31, 2023' throughout the legislation; on Page 1, Lines 14-22, to read 'WHEREAS, The Office of Economic and Workforce Development (OEWD) selected the Mid-Market Foundation (MMF) through a Request for Proposals to provide as needed project based support services that certain Grant Agreement by and between City and MMF, dated as of July 1, 2022 (Original Agreement), as amended by that certain First Amendment to Grant Agreement, dated as of November 14, 2022 (Amendment No. 1), which increased the contract amount to \$20,499,000, as authorized by Board of Supervisor's Resolution No. 468-22, adopted on November 8, 2022. The Original Agreement together with, Amendment No. 1, Amendment No. 2 and Amendment No. 3 are collectively referred to as, the "Agreement"; and ; and by making other clarifying and conforming amendments.
