Resolution adopting the City's Ten-Year Capital Expenditure Plan for Fiscal Years (FYs) 2024-2033 pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 3.20.

Heard in Committee. Speakers: Brian Strong, Director and Chief Resilience Officer (Office of Resilience and Capital Planning); Charlie Sheehan (Department of the Environment); Supervisor Aaron Peskin, President (Board of Supervisors); Anna Van Degna (Office of the Controller); Anne Pearson (Office of the City Attorney); provided an overview and responded to questions raised throughout the discussion. Elena Engle; Sarah Greenwald; Roni Diamant-Wilson; Judy Rosenfeld; Joyce Gallagos; Speaker; David Pilpel; Eileen Boken; Susan Green; Francisco Da Costa; Charlie Sciammas (Council of Community Housing Organizations; spoke on various concerns relating to the hearing matter.

Member Safai, seconded by Chair Chan, moved that this Resolution be AMENDED, AN AMENDMENT OF THE WHOLE BEARING SAME TITLE, on Page 3, Lines 7-10, by adding 'FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Board amends the Capital Plan to revise the amounts of the General Obligation bonds scheduled for 2024, such that the amount of the Affordable Housing & Shelter G.O. Bond shall be increased to \$340 million, and the amount of the Public Health and Shelter G.O. Bond shall be increased to \$320 million; and, be it'. The motion carried by the following vote:
