DATE OF RESCISSION: May 6, 2021

Effective immediately, Health Officer Directive No. 2020-07 is rescinded in full in accordance with the terms of that Directive. Pharmacies, Farmers' Markets and Stands, Grocers, others selling unprepared foods and household consumer products, and Hardware Stores must still comply with the terms of Health Officer Directive No. 2020-17 (Retail Businesses).
