The African American Arts and Cultural District Community Advisory Committee (the "Committee") was established to advise the Board of Supervisors, the Mayor, and the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development regarding strategies to support and preserve the unique culture and heritage of the African American Arts and Cultural District (the "District"), and provide input to all City agencies in the preparation of reports required under Administrative Code, Section 107A.2. These department reports shall contain assessments of relevant assets and needs in the District, recommendations on programs, policies, and funding sources that could benefit the District, and other recommendations that could serve the District to advance the goals of Administrative Code, Chapter 107A. The Committee shall also advise the Board of Supervisors, the Mayor, and the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development regarding any potential need to re-examine the boundaries of the African American Arts and Cultural District.

The Committee shall have the following qualifications:

• Seat 1: Shall be held by an owner of a business located in the African American Arts and Cultural District and resides within the boundaries of the African American Arts and Cultural District.

- Seat 2: Shall be held by an employee of a nonprofit organization located in the African American Arts and Cultural District and resides within the boundaries of the African American Arts and Cultural District.
- Seat 3: Shall be held by a person with knowledge or expertise regarding the history or culture of the African American Arts and Cultural District and resides within the boundaries of the African American Arts and Cultural District.
- Seat 4: Shall be held by a youth between ages of 14 to 24, inclusive, at the time of appointment and resides within the boundaries of the African American Arts and Cultural District.
- Seats 5, 6 & 7: Shall be an individual who resides within the boundaries of the African American Arts and Cultural District.

Members shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors and remain on the Committee until the termination of the Committee on January 31, 2023, unless the Committee is extended by Ordinance.

The Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development shall provide administrative support for the Committee. All City officials and agencies shall cooperate with the Committee in the performance of its functions.

All appointments and reappointments shall be for indefinite terms.
