2019 Budget Priorities

 BLA has solicited the top 3 budget priorities from each Board office.

- The following issues have been identified and are scheduled to be heard by B&F Committee:
 - April 10: Public Safety
 - April 17: Housing and Homelessness
 - April 24: Mental Health and Substance Abuse

Public Safety

- ☐ The following sub-issues have been identified by supervisors:
 - Car break-ins
 - Additional Police Officer positions
 - Restraining Orders (gun related)
 - Security for Muni operators
 - Prevention & Response measures
 - Multilingual community ambassadors & community officers
 - Block safety groups

Homelessness

- □ The following sub-issues have been identified by supervisors:
 - Capacity for beds and housing units, including supportive housing
 - Accelerating shelter bed commitments

Housing

- ☐ The following sub-issues have been identified by supervisors:
 - Small and large site acquisition
 - Anti-displacement measures
 - Specialized housing for:
 - Seniors
 - People with disabilities
 - Veterans
 - Workforce housing

Mental Health & Substance Abuse

- The following sub-issues have been identified by supervisors:
 - Outreach services
 - Increased capacity of residential treatment beds for individuals under 5150 holds or who present a danger to themselves or others
 - Increase in psychiatrists and intensive case managers

2019 Budget Priorities

- In addition, the following issues were mentioned by two or more supervisors:
 - Clean and Green Streets
 - MCO Funding to assist non-profits to meet the MCO obligation
 - Small Business Support

BLA Analysis

- □ BLA will conduct research on each priority including:
 - Status of established programs
 - Historical spending
 - Performance measures
 - Identification of funding impact opportunities

BLA Analysis: Programs & Spending

- BLA will review and report on established programs and historical spending related to the priority issue:
 - Identify relevant departments and programs
 - □ History
 - Goals
 - Service Populations
 - Historical spending by program when available

BLA Analysis: Performance Measures

- Review and summarize official performance measures as reported by the Controller's City Performance Unit
- Identify additional performance measures recorded by departments or otherwise readily available.
- Follow up on audit recommendations.

Performance Measures: Public Safety

- Crime rates
 - Property vs. violent crime
 - Property crime by type
- □ Investigation clearance rates
- Response times to calls for service
- Temporary restraining order service completion rates

Performance Measures: Housing

- ABAG Regional Housing Needs Assessment
 - Assessed need vs. actual construction
- Goals Outlined in MOHCD Strategic Plan
 - Number of units created by type
 - Number of units preserved or maintained
 - Increased affordability of rental housing
 - Increased opportunity for sustainable homeownership
 - Increase access to rental and homeownership housing
 - Reduce rate of evictions

Performance Measures: Homelessness

- Number of families receiving a rental subsidy
- Number of families that secured and/or maintained housing due to a one-time grant
- Number of individuals leaving homelessness due to placement in permanent supportive housing
- Number of individuals reunited with family or friends through Homeward Bound
- Number of single adults that secured and/or maintained housing due to one-time grant

Performance Measures: Homelessness (cont'd)

- Percent of case managed families in shelters that are placed in permanent or transitional housing, enter a treatment program, or reunite with family
- Number of individuals still in supportive housing or other appropriate placements after one year
- Percentage of all available year-round single adult homeless shelter beds used

Performance Measures: Mental Health & Substance Abuse Services

- □ DPH Targets vs. Actual:
 - Number of unique mental health clients in treatment
 - Percentage of new mental health clients who are homeless
 - Total units of mental health services provided
 - Residents under 19 years of age receiving services provided by Children's Mental Health Services
 - Number of unique substance abuse clients in treatment
 - Percentage of homeless clients among substance abuse treatment admissions
 - Total units of substance abuse treatment services provided

Performance Measures: Mental Health & Substance Abuse Services (cont'd)

- Mental Health Program Measures covering:
 - Crisis Residential services
 - Long-Term Care Residential services
 - Outpatient services
- □ Substance Abuse Program Measures covering:
 - Narcotic Replacement Treatment
 - Residential services
 - Outpatient services

Funding Impact Opportunities

- BLA will work to identify high impact budget enhancement opportunities by:
 - Soliciting opportunities from department staff
 - Reviewing audit recommendations
 - Reviewing FY 2018-19 budget priority reports for previously recommended enhancements that have not been undertaken
