**Next Steps:** Applicants must submit an application directly to the President of the Board of Supervisors and will be contacted by the staff of the Building Inspection Commission once they are appointed.

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The Building Inspection Commission consists of seven members, three of whom are appointed by the President of the Board of Supervisors consisting of a residential tenant, a residential landlord, and a member of the general public. The term shall be for two years, provided that the respective terms of office of those first appointed shall be as follows: Three for one year from the effective date of Charter Section Appendix D, D3750.1 (December 19, 1994). The other four members are appointed by the Mayor, including: a structural engineer, a licensed architect, a residential builder, and a representative of a community-based non-profit housing development corporation.

The Building Inspection Commission shall organize, reorganize, and manage the Department of Building Inspection which shall have responsibility for the enforcement, administration, and interpretation of the City's Housing, Building, Mechanical, Electrical, and Plumbing Codes, except where the Charter specifically grants that power to another department. The Central Permit Bureau shall also be managed by the Commission. Other powers and duties are stated in Charter Section D3750.4.
