NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BUDGET AND FINANCE COMMITTEE SAN FRANCISCO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to the general public that the Budget and Finance Committee will hold a public hearing on Monday, June 27, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., in the Legislative Chamber, Room 250, at City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, San Francisco, California to consider the following: File: 110706 Ordinance amending the San Francisco Administrative Code, Chapter 31, by amending Sections 31.22, 31.23, and 31.23.1 to increase all fees based on the Controller's annual two-year average consumer price index; and adopting findings, including environmental findings. The proposed legislation would amend Chapter 31 of the Administrative Code to increase all fees based on the Controller's annual two-year average consumer price index of 2.07% for the follows (excluding appeals fees): Basic Fees (SF Administrative Code, Section 31.22); Other Fees (SF Administrative Code, Section 31.23); Community Plan Fees (SF Administrative Code, Section 31.23.1). The Controller will annually adjust the fee amounts specified in Section 31.22(a)(1), (2), (5), (7), (8), (9), (10), (11), and (12), Section 31.22(b)(1) and (6) and Section 31.22(c), Section 31.23(d) and Section 31.23.1(a) and (b) by the two-year average consumer price index change for the San Francisco/San Jose Primary Metropolitan Statistical Area. File: 110707 Ordinance amending the San Francisco Planning Code by amending Article 3.5 to increase fees based on the Controller's annual two-year average consumer price index (CPI) and place a cap on the intake fee amount for applications for Planning Commission and Zoning Administrator hearing applications, certificates of appropriateness, and building permit applications; and adopting findings, including environmental findings, Planning Code Section 302 findings, and findings of consistency with the General Plan and the priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. The proposed legislation would amend the Planning Code by amending Article 3.5 to increase fees based on the Controller's annual two-year average consumer price index of 2.07% for the following: Fees, General (Planning Code, Section 350); Miscellaneous Services (Planning Code, Section 351); Commission and Zoning Administrator Hearing Application (Planning Code, Section 352); Downtown Applications (Planning Code, Section 353); Permit Application (Planning Code, Section 355); Preservation Applications (Planning Code, Section 356); Transportation Review Associated with Project Application (Planning Code, Section 357); General Advertising Signs Fees (Planning Code, Section 358). The proposed legislation would also add a new cap on the intake fee amount for applications for Planning Commission and Zoning Administrator hearing applications, certificates of appropriateness, and building permit applications. This cap would ensure that the initial fee amount not exceed 50% of the esti-

mated construction cost of the proposed project. Data in support of the proposed fee increases is available in the above-mentioned file of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors ten days prior to the hearing.
