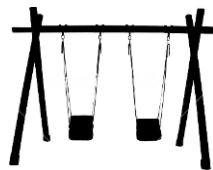

WHAT IS PARTICIPATORY BUDGETING?

Participatory Budgeting is a democratic process that gives community members the opportunity to set budgeting priorities and make decisions on what community projects should be funded.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

For the first time, District 7 residents will be able to help decide how best to spend \$300,000 for general projects and \$250,000 for pedestrian safety improvements in District 7.
