<u>Next Steps</u>: Applicants who meet minimum qualifications will be contacted by the Rules Committee Clerk once the Rules Committee Chair determines the date of the hearing. Members of the Rules Committee will consider the appointment(s) at the meeting and applicant(s) may be asked to state their qualifications. The appointment of the individual(s) who is recommended by the Rules Committee will be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors for final approval.

The Redistricting Task Force shall consist of nine members. The Board of Supervisors, the Mayor, and the Elections Commission shall each appoint three members. The Director of Elections shall serve ex officio as a non-voting member.

The membership of the Task Force shall be broadly representative of the communities of interest, neighborhoods, and diversity in ethnicity, race, age, gender, and sexual orientation of the City and County of San Francisco.

The Redistricting Task Force shall be responsible for redrawing supervisorial district lines in accordance with the law and shall make appropriate adjustments based on public input provided at community meetings.

As set forth in Charter section 13.110(d), district boundaries must conform to all applicable legal requirements, including the requirement that they be equal in population. Population variations between districts shall be limited to 1% from the statistical mean unless additional variations, limited to 5% of the statistical mean, are necessary to prevent dividing or diluting the voting power of minorities and/or to keep recognized neighborhoods intact; provided, however, that the redistricting shall conform to the rule of one person, one vote, and shall reflect communities of interest within the City and County of San Francisco.
