**SUPERVISOR KATY TANG RELEASES SUNSET DISTRICT BLUEPRINT TO
COMMUNITY**

Blueprint is first-of-its-kind created to comprehensively and strategically address district needs proactively

Supervisor Katy Tang today released the Sunset District Blueprint, a first-of-its-kind strategic plan for District 4. Developed to create a vision for the community with short and long-term goals, the Blueprint outlines objectives in five issue areas: Children, Families and Seniors; Economic Development; Land Use; Public Transportation and Pedestrian Safety; and Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness.

The Blueprint contains suggestions and recommendations distilled from 2,000 comments received through five public workshops, multiple drop-in community meetings throughout the district, and over 400 individual responses to an online survey.

“Through the Sunset District Blueprint, our office can serve as better advocates to bring needed resources to our district,” said Supervisor Tang. “We recognize that strategic planning is important in order to achieve both short and long-term goals, and our office strives to be proactive and comprehensive when it comes to serving our community.”

In addition to suggestions and recommendations for community improvements, the Blueprint also provides context for existing citywide efforts and initiatives. Objectives contained within the Blueprint will be updated each year through a status report to reflect accomplishments and new or revised goals.

“I was inspired by our City’s Ten-Year Capital Plan, which provides a roadmap for implementation and funding of major capital improvement projects in San Francisco,” said Supervisor Tang. “Our office wanted to create a district-focused plan in the same spirit and based on issues that our residents care about most.”
