Subject: **File No. 200814.** Hearing of the Board of Supervisors sitting as a Committee of the Whole on September 22, 2020, at 3:00 p.m., to hold a public hearing to consider an ordinance approving an amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Mission Bay South Redevelopment Project, which modifies the maximum number of hotel rooms permitted on Block 1 (also known as the site of the SOMA Hotel) at the intersection of Third Street and Channel Street; directing the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to transmit a copy of this Ordinance upon its enactment to the Successor Agency; making findings under the California Environmental Quality Act; and making findings of consistency with the General Plan, and the eight priority policies of Planning Code, Section 101.1(b).; to be scheduled pursuant to Motion No. M20-102, approved by the Board on August 11, 2020.

The purpose of the Redevelopment Plan Amendment is to permit additional hotel rooms on Block 1 in the Mission Bay South Redevelopment Plan area ("Plan Area"). The amendment will allow for an interior reconfiguration to split multi-room suites into individual hotel rooms for the Block 1 Hotel Project, which would increase the number of rooms on the site from the currently permitted 250 to 300.

The interior reconfiguration will allow the Block 1 Hotel owner to respond to market conditions.

The original legal description of the boundaries of the Plan Area was recorded as follows: the legal description of the Plan Area boundaries was recorded with the San Francisco Office of the Assessor-Recorder on November 18, 1998, as Document No. 98-G470337-00. The legal description of the Plan Area boundaries, as amended, was recorded with the San Francisco Office of the Assessor-Recorder on August 14, 2018, as Document No. 2018-K655138-00.

On March 17, 2020, the Board of Supervisors authorized their Board and Committee meetings to convene remotely and allow for remote public comment due to the Coronavirus -19 pandemic. Therefore, Board of Supervisors meetings that are held through videoconferencing will allow remote public comment.
