ORDINANCE NO. 1453

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALY CITY AMENDING CHAPTER 17.36 OF TITLE 17 OF THE DALY CITY MUNICIPAL CODE RE: HOME OCCUPATIONS.

The City Council of the City of Daly City, DOES ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 17.36 of the Daly City Municipal Code is hereafter amended to read as to read as follows:

Section 17.36.020 - Definition
A "home occupation" is a business, art or profession, the offering of a service, or the handcraft manufacture of products within a residential dwelling. A "home occupation" constitutes a secondary use of a residential dwelling and can be for profit or philanthropic. A "home occupation" is to be located and conducted such that the average neighbor, under normal circumstances, would not be aware of its existence. Any Microenterprise Home Kitchen Operation (MEHKO) as defined by Section 113825 of the California Health and Safety Code shall not be considered a "home occupation" for the purpose of this section. Such uses shall instead be permitted to operate subject to State and County laws and guidelines.

SECTION 2: Environmental Determination: The City Council of the City of Daly City finds and determines that the implementation of measures described in this Chapter is in furtherance police powers of the City of Daly City, and that these purposes are exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 21100) of Division 13 of the Public Resources Code, as provided in categorical exemption Classes 1, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, and or 21 of the CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, Sections 15301-15329).

SECTION 3: Effective Date and Publication: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage. This Ordinance shall be published according to law.

SECTION 4: Severability: If any section, subsection or sentence of this Ordinance is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unlawful, the City Council finds and declares that the remainder of this ordinance would be and is enforceable and would have been adopted notwithstanding the finding of invalidity as to any section, subsection or sentence.

decedent, you must file your claim with the court and mail a copy to the personal representative appointed by the court within the later of either (1) four months from the date of first issuance of letters to a general personal representative, as defined in section 58(b) of the California Probate Code, or (2) 60 days from the date of mailing or personal delivery to you of a notice under section 9052 of the California Probate Code. Other California statutes and legal authority may affect your rights as a creditor. You may want to consult with an attorney knowledgeable in California law.

You may examine the file kept by the court. If you are a person interested in the estate, you may file with the court a Request for Special Notice (form DE-154) of the filing of an inventory and appraisal of estate assets or of any petition or account as provided in Probate Code section 1250.
