Motion approving the Treasurer's nomination of Jackie Chen (residency requirement waived) to the Treasury Oversight Committee, for a term ending June 17, 2026.

[Appointment, Treasury Oversight Committee - Jackie Chen]

WHEREAS, The Treasury Oversight Committee for the City and County of San Francisco is established as an advisory body to the Treasurer to involve depositors of funds into the City Treasury in reviewing investment policies that guide the management of those funds and to enhance the security and investment return on those funds; and

WHEREAS, The Members of the Treasury Oversight Committee are nominated by the treasurer and approved or rejected by by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Administrative Code, Section 5.9-3, the Treasurer of the City and County of San Francisco has submitted notification to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the nomination of Jackie Chen to the Treasury Oversight Committee, received by the Clerk of the Board on June 26, 2024; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby approves the Treasurer of the City and County of San Francisco's nomination of Jackie Chen (residency requirement waived), seat 2, succeeding Megan Wallace, to the Treasury Oversight Committee, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending June 17, 2026; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 1. The membership of the Treasury Oversight Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 2. Applicant Jackie Chen, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies them to serve on the Treasury Oversight Committee.

- 3. The Treasury Oversight Committee has attempted to fill the position, for which Jackie Chen was nominated, with an individual who is City a resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has certified that Jackie Chen is qualified to serve on the Treasury Oversight Committee.
- 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no other possible representatives who is a resident of San Francisco, who has the specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Treasury Oversight Committee at this time; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement for Jackie Chen, as is allowed in cases where no qualified City resident who is willing to serve can be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101 (a)(2), that otherwise requires person(s) appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
