WHEREAS, The function of regular performance audits is to ensure that City departments and agencies make prudent and efficient use of City resources and also effectively perform the functions assigned to them by the Charter and applicable laws; and now be it;

MOVED, That the Budget and Legislative Analyst is hereby directed to initiate a performance audit in Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-2026 of the Recreation and Park Department, including, but not limited to: (i) any and all financial and in-kind relationships with SF Parks Alliance, including but not limited to any special restricted funds for the General Manager and the Recreation and Park Commission as well as partnerships with other third party nonprofit organizations and public/private partnerships; (ii) fee schedules and reservation systems for use of and/or entry to park property; (iii) management and oversight of concessions on park land; and (iv) equitable access to, and distribution of, park services across the City and processes for acquiring new park land.
