Ordinance amending the Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code to update the

Conflict of Interest Code's Form 700 (Statement of Economic Interests) filing

requirements by adding, deleting, and changing titles of certain designated officials

and employees to reflect organizational and staffing changes, and by refining

disclosure requirements for certain designated officials and employees.

#### SEC. 3.1-195. CONTROLLER.

(a) Disclosure Category 2. Refuse Rates Administrator. # SEC. 3.1-500. POSITIONS FOR WHICH THE FAIR POLITICAL PRACTICES COMMISSION IS THE FILING OFFICER.

Members of the Board of Supervisors, District Attorney, Mayor, City Administrator, City Attorney, Treasurer, and members of the Planning Commission shall electronically file one original of all statements of economic interests with the Ethics Commission, the filing official, who shall electronically transmit *a seanned copy the statements* to the Fair Political Practices Commission which shall be the filing officer.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,

numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
