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3 **Ordinance authorizing settlement of the lawsuit filed by Willie Crawford against the City**  
4 **and County of San Francisco for payment by City of \$100,281; the lawsuit was filed on**  
5 **March 2, 2015, in the Superior Court, and removed on March 16, 2016, to the Federal**  
6 **District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. 16-cv-01301-CW; entitled Willie**  
7 **Crawford v. City and County of San Francisco; the lawsuit involves a dispute arising**  
8 **from employment; other material terms of the settlement are that plaintiff will resign,**  
9 **and that the City agrees to restore vacation pay, pay severance in accordance with the**  
10 **Municipal Executives' Association collective bargaining agreement, pay the fee for**  
11 **mediation of the dispute, and forgo certain attorney's fees and costs awarded by court.**

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13 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter, Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby  
15 authorizes the settlement of the action entitled Willie Crawford v. City and County of San  
16 Francisco, United States District Court, Northern District of California, Case No. 16-cv-01301-  
17 CW by the payment of \$100, 281, with other material terms being: plaintiff will resign, and  
18 that the City agrees to restore vacation pay, pay severance in accordance with the Municipal  
19 Executives' Association collective bargaining agreement, pay the fee for mediation of the  
20 dispute, and forgo certain attorney's fees and costs awarded by court.. The lawsuit involves a  
21 dispute arising from employment with the City.

22 Section 2. The above-named action was filed on March 2, 2015 in the Superior Court,  
23 and removed on March 16, 2016 to the Federal District Court, Northern District of California,  
24 Case No. 16-cv-01301-CW, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Willie  
25 Crawford, plaintiff, City and County of San Francisco, defendant.




