Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings.

- When Administrative Code Chapter 109 was enacted, certain approvals and permits by City departments and agencies were required for affordable housing projects. Administrative Code Chapter 109 was enacted to prioritize the approvals and permits for affordable housing, and for the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD") to submit quarterly reports on the status of such approvals and permits. MOHCD's quarterly reports assisted with identifying City departments and agencies that were reviewing affordable housing projects and had pending approvals.
- Since the enactment of Administrative Code Chapter 109, state law has been (b) changed to require a streamlined permit process for affordable housing through ministerial approvals by City departments and agencies, the City has established a central Permit Center

available to the public to track the status of permits online, and a Director of Housing Delivery has been appointed to help facilitate the approval of housing in the City. In light of these developments, a more limited set of information on housing approvals in MOHCD's reports is now needed, and the reports need not be as frequent as before.

Section 2. Chapter 109 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Section 109.3, to read as follows:

SEC. 109.3. *QUARTERLY*REPORTS.

- (a) Quarterly Reports. Beginning on December 15, 2018, the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD") shall provide a report to the Board of Supervisors and the Mayor about the status of 100% Affordable Housing Projects pending before the Department of Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire Department, Mayor's Office on Disability, and Planning Department, and shall provide subsequent reports every three months thereafter with the final quarterly report due December 15, 2024. The Department of Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire Department, Mayor's Office on Disability, and Planning Department shall provide MOHCDthe Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development with the information necessary to compile these reports. Each quarterly report, ates a minimum, shall provide:
- (1a) a list of every 100% Affordable Housing Project that has applied for approval, permit, or other City authorization from the Department of Building Inspection, Public Works, Fire Department, Mayor's Office on Disability, or Planning Department;
- $(\underline{2}b)$ information regarding the financing and financing-related deadlines for each 100% Affordable Housing Project:

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles, numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.
