Ordinance authorizing settlement of two related lawsuits filed by Park Hotels & Resorts Inc. et al. against the City and County of San Francisco concerning the real property located at 375 Battery Street, San Francisco, CA (Assessor's Parcel Block No. 0229, Lot No. 020) (the "Subject Property") for a stipulated assessed value of the Subject Property of \$220,345,336 as of September 18, 2019, contingent upon the Assessment Appeals Board's approval, and a refund of \$1,716,129 plus statutory interest; the first lawsuit was filed on August 18, 2023, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-23-608468; entitled <u>Park Hotels & Resorts Inc., et al. v. City and County of San Francisco</u>; the second lawsuit was filed on June 27, 2023, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-23-607304; entitled <u>Park Hotels & Resorts Inc. v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.</u>; the lawsuits involve the assessed value of the Subject Property for property tax purposes as of the September 18, 2019, change in ownership date and a transfer tax refund; and repealing Ordinance No. 262-24, which authorized a prior settlement of these lawsuits.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled <u>Park Hotels & Resorts Inc., et al. v.</u> <u>City and County of San Francisco</u>, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-23-608468, for a stipulated assessed value of the real property located at 375 Battery Street, San

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Francisco, CA (APN 0229-020) of \$220,345,336 as of September 18, 2019, contingent upon the Assessment Appeals Board's approval;

Section 2. The action in Section 1 was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on August 18, 2023, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: Park Hotels & Resorts Inc., a Delaware Corporation, PK Domestic Property LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability Company, CHSP San Francisco LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability Company, and CHSP TRS San Francisco LLC, a Delaware Limited Liability Company, Plaintiffs; and City and County of San Francisco, Defendant.

Section 3. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled <u>Park Hotels & Resorts Inc., et al. v.</u> <u>City and County of San Francisco, et al.</u>, San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-23-607304, for the payment of \$1,716,129, plus statutory interest. The lawsuit involves a transfer tax refund.


