

1 [Grant Agreement - Retroactive - Young Community Developers - Black to the Future and  
2 School Site Mentoring Program - Not to Exceed \$12,422,660]

3 **Resolution retroactively approving a Grant Agreement between the City and County of**  
4 **San Francisco, acting by and through the Department of Children, Youth and Their**  
5 **Families (“DCYF”), and Young Community Developers for the following programs:**  
6 **Black to the Future and the School Site Mentoring Program, for a term of five years**  
7 **from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029, and for a total not to exceed amount of**  
8 **\$12,422,660; and to authorize the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families to**  
9 **enter into amendments or modifications to the Agreement that do not materially**  
10 **increase the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the**  
11 **purposes of the Agreement or this Resolution.**

13 WHEREAS, On August 16, 2023, the Department of Children, Youth and Their  
14 Families (“DCYF”) issued a Request for Proposals (“RFP”) for its 2024-2029 funding cycle;  
15 and

16 WHEREAS, Young Community Developers submitted proposals for two programs  
17 under RFP Result Area: All Children And Youth Are Supported By Nurturing Families And  
18 Communities; and

19 WHEREAS, The two programs are: Black to the Future and School Site Mentoring  
20 Program; and

21 WHEREAS, Young Community Developers was awarded funding in both programs;  
22 and

23 WHEREAS, Under the Black to the Future Program, Young Community Developers will  
24 provide wrap-around services focusing on family support and advocacy, health and wellness,

1 education, workforce development and violence prevention to San Francisco youth ages 5-24;  
2 and

3 WHEREAS, Under the School Site Mentoring Program, Young Community Developers  
4 will provide crisis intervention, implementation of prevention strategies, responses to incidents  
5 of violence to San Francisco Middle and High School at-risk youth; and

6 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b), requires Board of Supervisors' approval by  
7 Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any  
8 contract which, when entered into, cost the City \$10,000,000 or more; and

9 WHEREAS, The proposed Grant Agreement contained in File No. 250015, is  
10 substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to  
11 be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Grant Agreement in  
13 substantially the form contained in File No. 250015; and, be it

14 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes DCYF to make any  
15 modifications to the Grant Agreement, prior to its final execution by all parties, that DCYF  
16 determines, in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the  
17 best interest of the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are  
18 necessary or advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Grant Agreement, and are in  
19 compliance with all applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Grant Agreement being fully  
21 executed by all parties, the DCYF shall submit to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a  
22 completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 250015; this requirement and obligation  
23 resides with DCYF, and is for purposes of having a complete file only, and in no manner  
24 affects the validity of approved Agreement.
