## RESOLUTION NO. 167-25

[Urging the Planning Department and Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development to Finalize the Affordable Housing Sites Strategy]

Resolution urging the Planning Department and Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development to finalize the Affordable Housing Sites Strategy; and to include the Strategy as part of the legislation package for the Housing Element Zoning Program.

WHEREAS, The Affordable Housing Sites Strategy is key to achieving the City and County of San Francisco's affordable housing goals, led by the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development and the Planning Department; and

WHEREAS, The Affordable Housing Sites Strategy shall recommend strategies for identifying, acquiring, and maintaining suitable locations for affordable housing citywide, informed by community needs, financial feasibility, and programmatic realities; and

WHEREAS, The Affordable Housing Sites Strategy will advance the goals of the 2022 Housing Element and Affirmatively Furthering Fair Housing by informing land acquisition for affordable housing citywide; and

WHEREAS, As part of the Affordable Housing Sites Strategy, the Planning Department shall review local and state housing laws and research incentives and best practices for site acquisition, rezoning, public land use, and public / private partnerships throughout San Francisco; and

WHEREAS, The Affordable Housing Sites Strategy shall explore best practices and strategies for developing specific types of sites, such as public lands and properties owned by religious and non-profit organizations, to affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco will be implementing a rezoning program to increase the capacity for new housing development along many of the City's

neighborhood commercial and transit corridors in both the Housing Opportunity Areas in the western and northern neighborhoods as well as in Priority Equity Geographies (PEGs); and

WHEREAS, These areas where the rezoning program is proposed include untapped opportunity sites for 100% affordable housing and housing preservation projects, many of which struggle to compete against for-profit developers and investors to acquire sites; and

WHEREAS, To ensure that the city's rezoning program advances housing at all income levels, including 100% affordable projects, it is critical that the City advance a proactive and affirmative approach to affordable housing sites acquisition; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors recognizes that the Affordable Housing Sites Strategy is a critical complement of the city's affordable housing strategy that must inform and be implemented alongside the city's rezoning program; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Planning Department and Mayor's Office of Housing & Community Development to finalize the Affordable Housing Sites Strategy and to include the Strategy as part of the legislation package for the Housing Element Zoning Program.
